EU ETS Regulation – New Emission Fee (NEF) Charge

Update to advisory dated November 20th, 2023

Dear Valued Customer,

Following the [advisory](#) dated November 20th, 2023, we wish to update that **the following are the current New Emissions Fee (NEF) rates effective as of January 1st, 2024, for all sailings arriving to or departing from EU ports**, till further notice, applying to FAK (Freight All Kind) cargo, for the relevant trades below*

The below rates are related to trades that were not included in the previous advisory published on November 20th, 2023.
